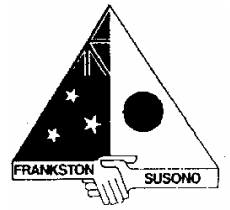


Environmental Control Services FSFA Exchange Student Award



Mission Statement

The mission of the Environmental Control Services Exchange Student Award is:

- to provide financial support to deserving local Frankston community students who have successfully completed a nine month exchange in Susono Japan as a participant in the Frankston Susono Friendship Association student exchange program.
- to assist in the further promotion, marketing and development of the Frankston Susono Friendship Association by way of displaying local Australian business support of the sister city relationship.
- to provide an incentive for high school students to participate in the FSFA student exchange program.

Environmental Control Services FSFA Exchange Student Award Eligibility

Applicants must be Australian citizens

Applicants must residence in the city of Frankston or attend a secondary school in Frankston.

Must have successfully completed a minimum Nine (9) month FSFA student exchange program.

Must demonstrate Academic success in the Japanese language (receive a score which demonstrates reasonable proficiency in the Japanese language) through a proficiency test undertaken during the stay in Susono.

Demonstrate knowledge and interest in various areas of the Japanese Culture

Must be involved in Japanese Extracurricular activities and awards

Comply with the rules of the Student Exchange Program.

Provide a 2 page typed essay that addresses your experience in the FSFA student exchange program, generally over viewing the following topics.

- PERSONAL, FAMILY AND ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS
- FUTURE ACADEMIC PLANS AND CAREER GOALS
- PAST, CURRENT AND FUTURE EFFORTS TOWARD MAKING A DIFFERENCE IN THE LOCAL COMMUNITY

Successful applicant to participate in official presentation award of the scholarship fund.

Applicant and parents to participate in brief video documentary that outlines the success of the FSFA student exchange program.
